
Chicago and Turabian Formatting and Content

A Chicago/Turabian (CMST) aper should follow the general formatting guidelines and include a nonnumbered cover page, a numbered main body feat for the bottom of each page where itations are made, and a successively mbered bibliography.

- 1 Centered, Boldface or Italic Type, Headlinestyle Capitalization

- **3** Flush Left, Boldface or Italic Type, Headlinestyle Capitalization
- 4 **f**in
- **5** Run in at beginning of paragraph (no blank line after), boldface or italic type, sentence style capitalization, terminal period

Below is an example of the five heading levels.




